With such disheartening numbers, you may be wondering if you should venture out on your own and start a business, and whether or not you'll succeed as an entrepreneur. The good news is,

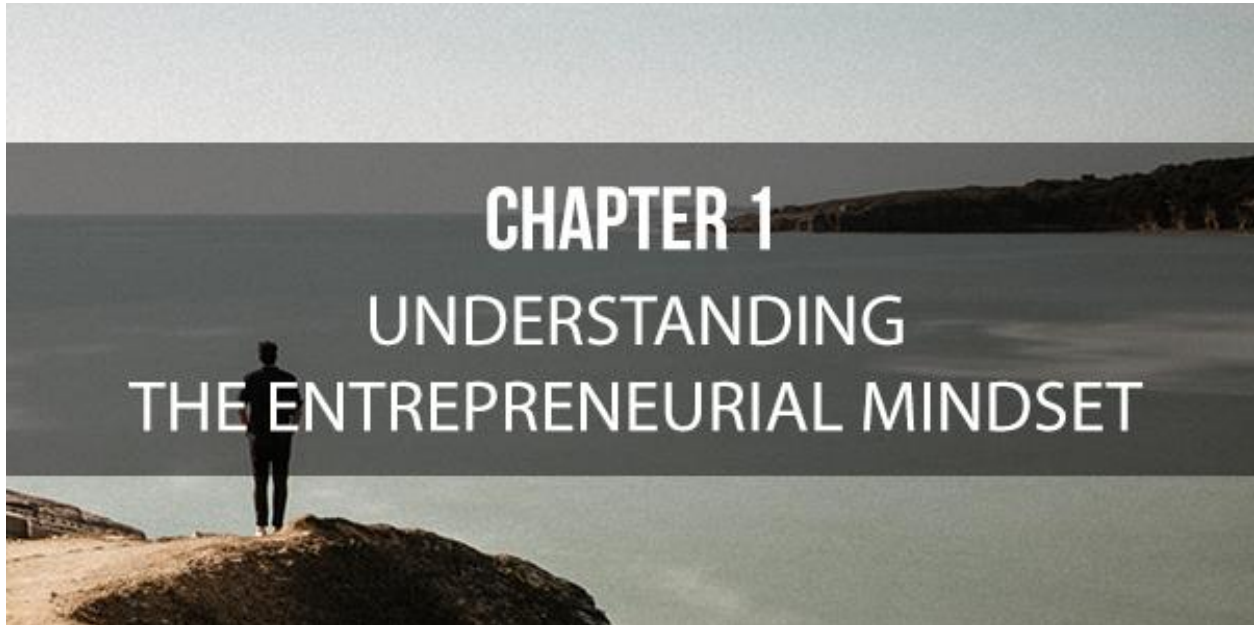

Your business success hinges on your ability to look failure in the face and find the courage to trudge forward until you've accomplished your goals. This requires you to increase your grit and perseverance.

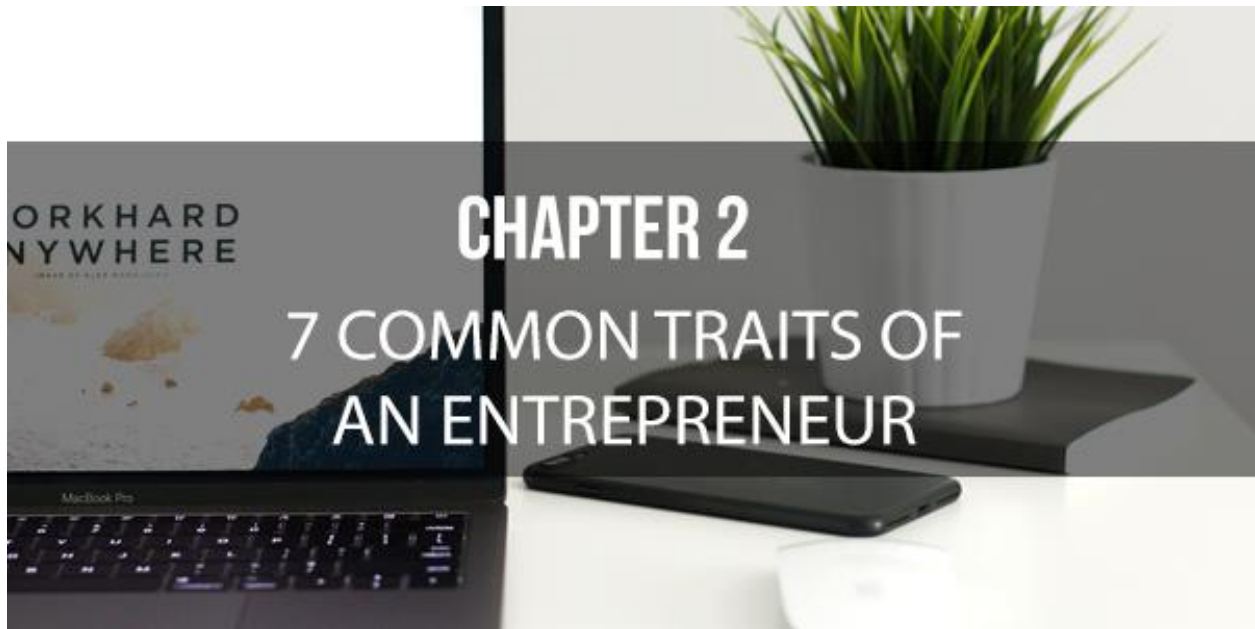
Productivity

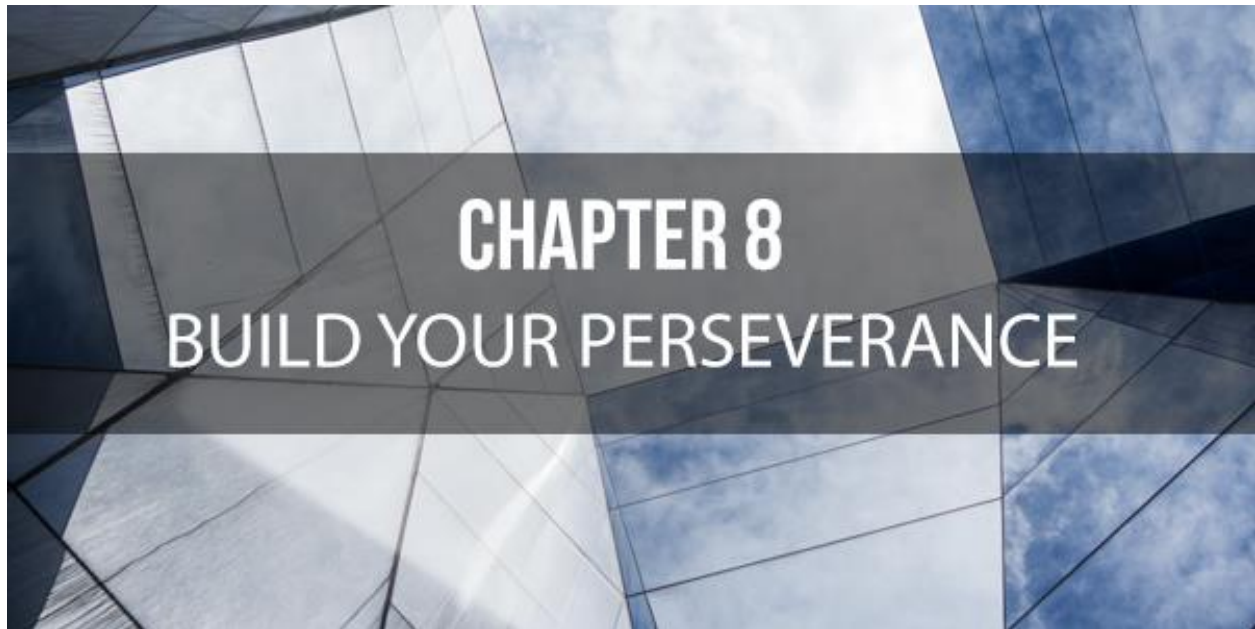

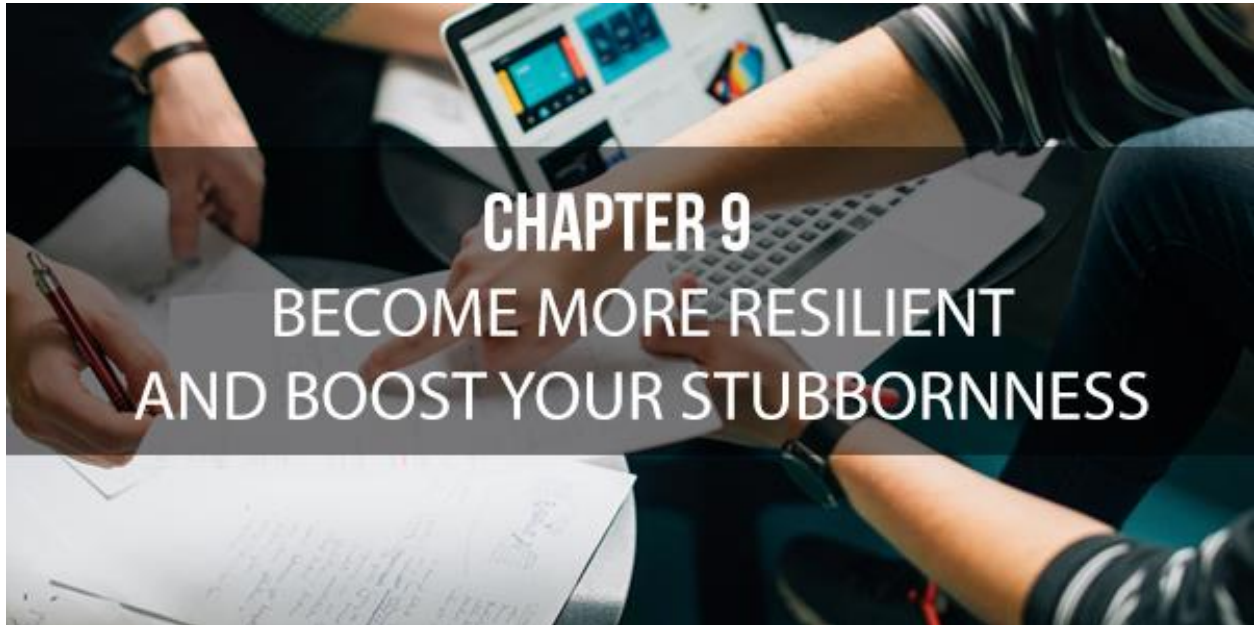
